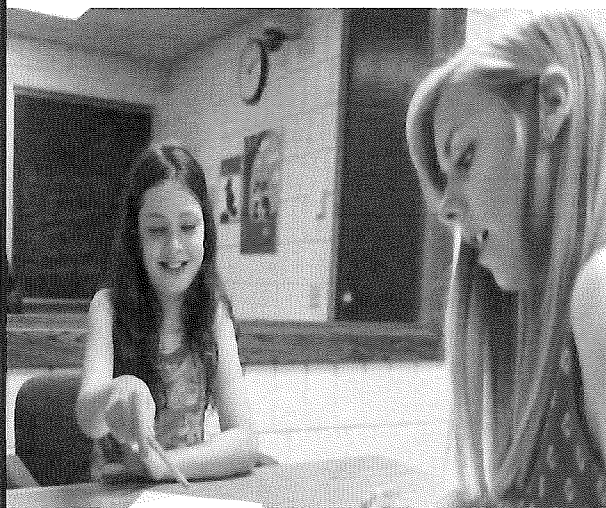

### ALL SKILLS = Comprehensive Skill Training, FEE = \$125

The mission of POPS camp is to introduce each individual skill of the game on Day 1 and progress to more advanced training on Day 2. Drills are designed to challenge and improve the performance of **ALL PLAYERS**, regardless of position. High repetition **BALL HANDLING** drills encourage the development of technically sound techniques used while passing, setting, and playing defense; **SCORING** drills break down the execution and timing of attacking, blocking, and serving. Drills highlighting **TEAMWORK** will emphasize the importance of all players having the proficiency to successfully perform all skills. Open to grades 7-12.
