Our virtue for the month of May is **Responsibility**. Our students will be working on accepting responsibility for our actions, leading through example and caring for our Earth.

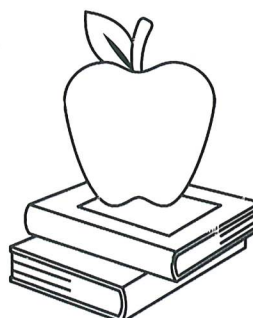

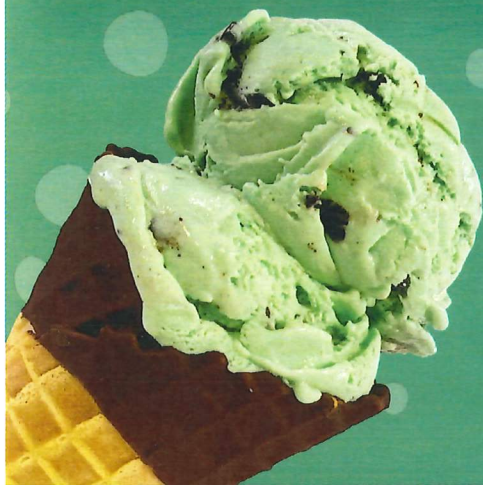
