Late applications and late required documents will NOT be accepted for any reason.

(IMPORTANT NOTE: Any non-voucher student currently attending Regis Catholic Schools may apply to the program only when entering kindergarten, 1st, and 9th grade.) The St. Benedict Tuition Assistance Scholarship is also currently accepting applications and is based on financial need. To apply for the 2025-26 school year, a family must complete and submit the FACTS Grant & Aid Application by the deadline of April 17. This application is kept confidential by FACTS.
